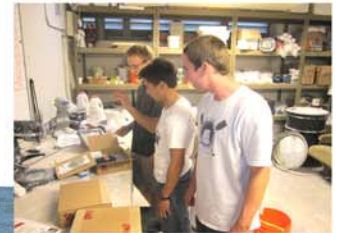
CONCRETE CANOOOOOOO
